### Requirements

- Updated CV on file
- Updated 1 paragraph biosketch on file
- Ecological or ecology-related research program at SIUC
- Use CFE affiliation on all relevant papers, posters, proposals, and other professional products; link web page to CFE web page
- Signed up on listserv

### Privileges

- Full voting privileges
- Eligible to direct or serve on CFE committees
- Eligible to apply for any seed grants, travel funds, assistantships, etc. that the CFE makes available
- Eligible to mentor CFE undergraduate summer interns
- Center membership is being incentivized by the VCR – will have to be a member of a center at SIU to apply for some upcoming programs
- Web page linked to CFE web page
- name on student recruitment materials (if desired)
- Invited to all seminars, social functions, and meetings

- Updated CV on file
- Signed up on listserv
